## RADIO AMATEUR LICENSE PLATES

The following information was received from the Michigan Department of State:

### ELIGIBILITY FOR AMATEUR RADIO OPERATOR

Only persons holding one of the following types of unexpired Amateur Radio licenses issued by the Federal Communications Commission are eligible for call letter license plates under Michigan Law (P.A. 300 of 1949 as amended: Section 217a):

1. Technician
2. General
3. Conditional
4. Advanced
5. Extra Class

CITIZENS BAND LICENSEES ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR CALL LETTER LICENSE PLATES.

Please return a copy of your title (vehicle) and a copy of your ARO license, when returning your preliminary.

For those of you who want to obtain license plates with your call letters, visit your local office of the Michigan Secretary of State and obtain an application. They will inform you of the procedure to follow.

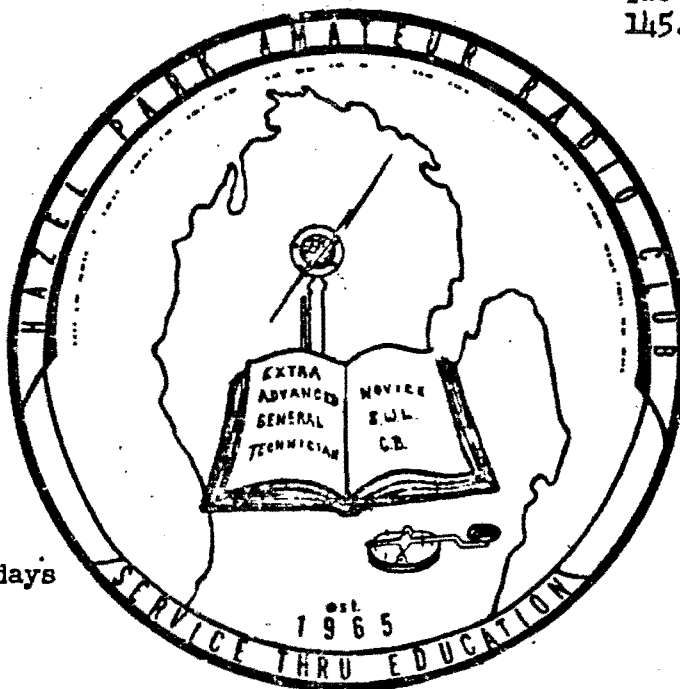

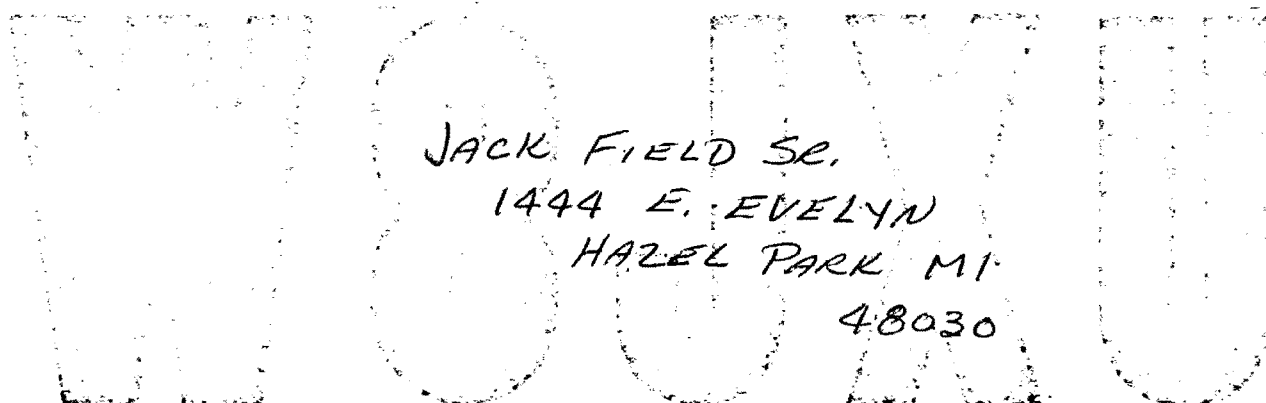
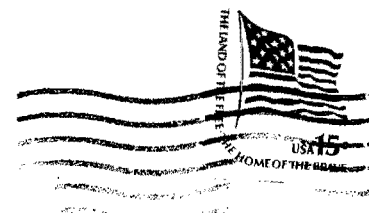
