Discussion followed on radio jammers.

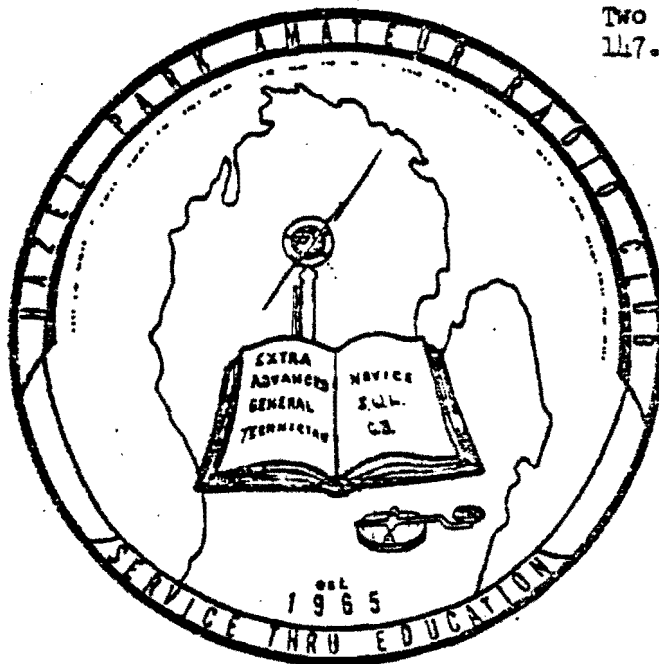
Notice was given that at the Dec. meeting there may be a special ballot for the voting for President of the club. Rob indicated that he may have to work nights. He will let us know at the meeting.

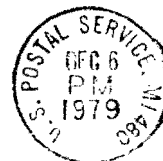
