QSL CARDS

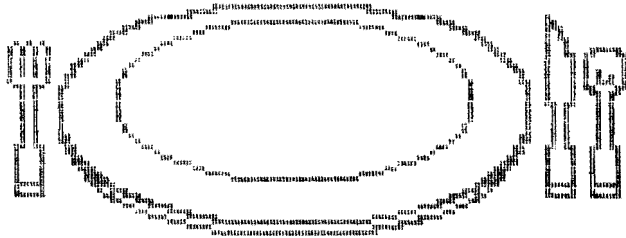
