The Board has proposed spending \$4,125 of the \$5,405.19 on hand, including setting aside \$2,500 to fund next December's Swap.

The banquet allocation is the same as last year but would not be spent if no one comes forward to coordinate it.

Club insurance from whatever source will be a lot more than last year, reflecting the higher costs of liability insurance for almost anyone except homeowners.

The \$100 allocation for special events was not spent last year. One proposal this year is using some of it toward establishing a club 10-10 chapter.

The \$60 flower fund allocation was not spent last year.

The \$100 allocation for classes includes purchase of used straight keys and oscillators at swaps to reduce cost to students to that of the book and tape only -- about \$12 instead of as much as \$50.

CW Trophy

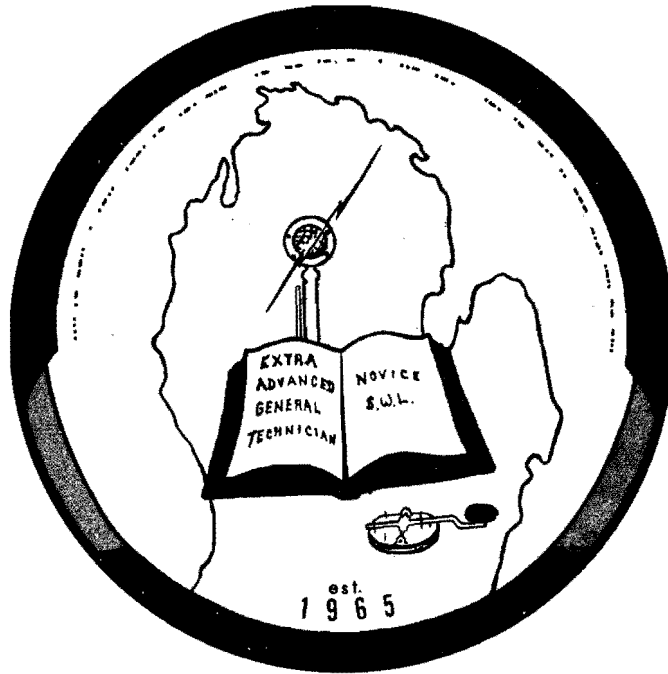

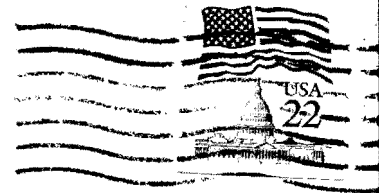
